

- The owner of the funeral establishment is legally obligated to inform his or her employees about OSHA safety and health standards and to provide a Safety Policy Manual, which contains disclosures about potential workplace hazards.
- Safety Policy Manuals communicates to the employee what the employer will do to ensure a safe workplace.
- Safety Policy Manuals communicate to the employee what the employee is expected to do to ensure a safe workplace for himself or herself and co-workers.

The Safety Policy Manual will contain the following items:

- Hazard Communication Program
- Chemical Spill Policy
- Bloodborne Pathogen Policy
- Exposure Control Plan
- Infectious Control Plan
- Bloodborne Pathogen Infectious Spill Policy and Waste Management
- Decontamination & Cleaning Policy
- Needlestick Protection Act Policy
- Respirator Protection Policy
- Fire Prevention Policy
- Lockout/Tagout Policy
- Crematory Policy, where applicable
- Confined Space Policy

The funeral establishment should have at least one Safety Policy Manual in each facility.
